

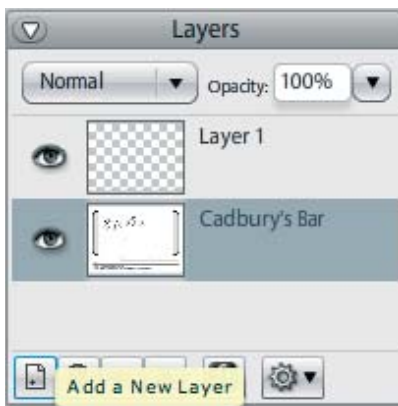


A quick guide to using the Cadbury Studio

Even if you're only a little familiar with using a paint program or web design software then you'll find it easy to use Cadbury Studio to create your wrapper design. So here's a few simple pointers to help you on your way.

1. Start by creating a new layer

When you open the program you'll see the wrapper template. You don't want to lose this so add a new layer first. Here's how:



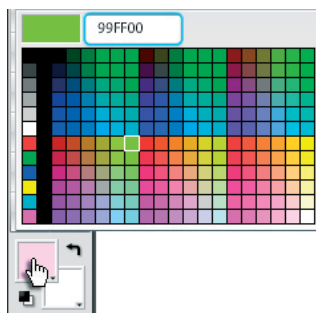
- The Layers box is in the lower right-hand corner of your screen. If you can't see it straight away just contract the Swatches box above it by clicking the arrow icon
- Click the Add a New Layer icon to create a new layer: Layer 1
- Start creating your wrapper design on Layer 1
- By creating new layers for each element of your artwork you will have more control of colour and positioning.

2. Using the tool bar

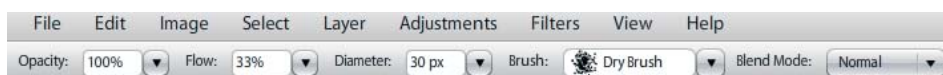
The toolbar contains everything you need to create your wrapper design: pens, paint brushes, erasers, shapes and tools for adding special effects and text. Here's brief guide to some of the tools you will use most often:



To change the colour you're working with click the palette at the foot of the tool bar to activate the colour selector. Click your chosen colour to work with that colour.



When you select the brush tool you can change its attributes – shape, strength, style – by using the toolbar just above your working canvas.

Eraser Tool

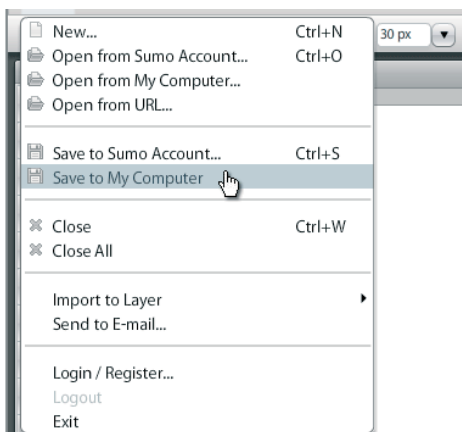
3. Working with images

If you want to include an image such as a photograph, a sketch or a piece of clip art in your wrapper design, here's how:

- Click File then click Import to Layer
- Choose the location of your image: on your computer or on the internet
- Once the image is imported (as a new layer), drag it into the centre of your canvas
- Click Edit and then Free Transform to work with your imported image.

4. Saving and submitting your wrapper design

When you're happy with your wrapper design you'll need to save it and then enter it into our competition through the Cadbury Apprentice website. Here's how:



- Save your wrapper design to your computer's desktop by clicking File and then clicking Save to My Computer
- Go to www.cadbury.ie/theapprentice and go to the How to Enter section to complete your details
- When your details are complete, click the Upload My Design button
- Choose the file you saved earlier to your computer then click Submit.
